



1. **DELIVERY:** To the street address specified by Lessee (Customer). Lessee grants Lessor right to enter the property at the said street address ("Delivery Address") for the delivery and subsequent pick up of the AIR JUMP UNIT at the specified time.
2. **TRANSPORTATION EXPENSE:** Except as provided herein, all charges in delivering and subsequent pick up of the AIR JUMP UNIT with respect, of the Delivery Address is included in the Rental Fee. In the event that AIR JUMP UNIT is to be returned by the Lessor and not returned at the appointed time Lessee will bill for each hour in which the AIR BOUCE UNIT is still under Lessors control. Lessor agrees that the AIR JUMP UNIT is to be vacated and empty at the requested end time. Additional charges will incur if pickup agent must wait for the equipment to be vacated.
3. **GENERAL RULES TO FOLLOW DURING USE OF THE AIR JUMP UNIT.**
 - a. Only compatible age groups and size shall play on the AIR JUMP UNIT at the same time. The maximum number of rides of each group that should play in AIR JUMP UNIT are: 13x13 unit: age under 8: 8-10, age 8 to 12: 4-6, Older teens: 3-4, Adults: 3. 15x15 unit: age under 8: 10-12, age 8 to 12: 7-9, Older teens: 4-6, Adults: 4.
 - b. All Riders MUST REMOVE SHOES & JEWELLERY before playing in the AIR JUMP UNIT.
 - c. To avoid neck and back injuries, FLIPS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
 - d. CHILDREN'S SAFETY DEPENDS UPON YOU. YOUR PERSONAL SUPERVISION IS ABSOLUTELY REQUIRED. AS THE LESSEE OF THE AIR JUMP UNIT, THE SAFETY OF ALL RIDERS IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.
 - e. Absolutely no "Silly String", gum, candy, food or other sticky substances are allowed in the AIR JUMP UNIT. If upon pick up, such cleaning is required then a minimum \$100.00 cleaning fee shall be automatically imposed.
 - f. No food, drinks, animals, shoes, or sharp objects are allowed in the rentals at any time.
 - g. DO NOT MOVE the AIR JUMP UNIT from the place where it was installed. If the AIR JUMP UNIT moves, pull the corner back to its original location of installation. CAUTION: Keep the AIR JUMP UNIT away from swimming pools and other potential dangers.
 - h. Rentals that are set up on hard surfaces such as concrete or asphalt must be closely watched by the Lessor to prevent their moving. If the equipment moves off the provided tarp, damage or staining may occur on the bottom of the unit and repair/cleaning fees, payable by the Lessor, may incur.
 - i. If the Lessee chooses to deflate the equipment prior to the arrival of the pick-up attendant, it must be reinflated before it is packed up.
4. **SPECIAL INSTRUCTION:** The AIR JUMP UNIT's equipment is reliable. Should the AIR JUMP UNIT begin to deflate: (1) the motor may have stopped, in which case, check the cord connection at the outlet near the motor. (2) If the motor is continuing to run, check the air intake on the side of the motor for blockage, and check both tubes at the back of the AIR JUMP UNIT for snugness; retie if necessary. (3) If you cannot detect the problem within 5 minutes you are required to call Air Jump Inc. immediately as set out in paragraph 5..
5. **SAFE OPERATION ACKNOWLEDGMENT:** LESSEE ACKNOWLEDGES THAT HE/SHE HAS BEEN INSTRUCTED ABOUT AND FULLY UNDERSTANDS THE SAFE OPERATION OF THE AIR JUMP UNIT THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THIS RENTAL AGREEMENT. LESSEE AGREES TO OBSERVE ALL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS. LESSEE ALSO REPRESENTS AND WARRANTS THE SAFE RETURN OF THE UNIT AND HEREBY AGREES TO PAY FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4000.00) PER UNIT IF IT IS NOT RETURNED. In the event of an emergency, in the event that the AIR JUMP UNIT ceases to operate as intended ,or in the event that the Lessor or riders becomes aware of potential dangers the Lessor is obligated to attempt contact Air Jump Inc. immediately at (403) 795-JUMP until contact has been made. If Lessee fails to contact Air Jump Inc., the Lessor is not responsible for any refunds.
6. **MAINTENANCE:** Lessee agrees to keep the AIR JUMP UNIT in the same condition as when received, ordinary wear accepted.
7. **ALTERATION AND ATTACHMENTS:** No alteration in or attachments to the AIR JUMP UNIT will be made without prior written approval of Lessor.
8. **WARRANTY:** Lessor warrants that the AIR JUMP UNIT leased under this Rental Agreement will be in good working order on the effective date of the Rental Agreement. The AIR JUMP UNIT is supplied and maintained subject to this warranty. Lessor's obligation under this Rental Agreement is limited to repair or replacement of the AIR JUMP UNIT when Lessor determines that it does not conform to this warranty. That warranty is in lieu of any and all other warranties expressed or implied, and of any and all obligations and of all liabilities on the part of Lessor for damages, including, but not limited to, consequential damages, arising out of or in connection with the use or performance of the AIR JUMP UNIT.

9. **TITLE TO AIR JUMP UNIT:** lessee agrees to keep the AIR JUMP UNIT in his/her custody and not to sublease, rent, sell, remove from the delivery address, or otherwise transfer such AIR JUMP UNIT. The AIR JUMP UNIT will remain the property of the Lessor and may be removed by Lessor at any time after the termination of The Rental Agreement.
10. **RELEASE OF LIABILITY:** The lessee shall be in charge of the AIR JUMP UNIT's operation and is fully responsible for its operation as well as return of the AIR JUMP UNIT in good working order. The Lessee expressly assumes the responsibility of informing all person(s) who use, operate or rent the above specified rental equipment that, they do so at their own risk and that, if any injury occurs to the person(s) using, operating or renting the equipment. Lessor and its officers, Employees, affiliates and agents is/are not responsible for injury, damages, or loss occurring to the lessee or to any other persons using the AIR JUMP UNIT, and the lessee further agrees to hold the Lessor and its officers, employees, affiliates and agents free and Harmless against any injury or claims. The lessee shall indemnify the Lessor and its officers, employees, affiliates and agents From/against any costs incurred due to claims from anyone and for attorney's fees and related costs involving the use and return of the AIR JUMP UNIT, should legal action become necessary.
11. **DUTY TO MITIGATE-** IN THE EVENT OF INJURY, DAMAGE OR LOSS DUE TO LESSOR'S NEGLIGENCE, LESSEE AGREES AND ASSUMES THE DUTY TO MITIGATE ALL COSTS RESULTING FROM SAID INJURY, DAMAGE OR LOSS.
12. **DISCLAIMER OF CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES-** BY SIGNING THIS CONTRACT, LESSEE AGREES TO FOREGO SEEKING ANY CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES IN THE EVENT OF ANY INJURY DAMAGE OR LOSS DUE TO LESSOR'S NEGLIGENCE.
13. **DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES-** LESSOR MAKES NO WARRANTIES EITHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED AS TO THE CONDITION OR PERFORMANCE OF ANY EQUIPMENT AND/OR PROPERTY LEASED BY LESSEE FROM LESSOR. BY SIGNING THIS CONTRACT, LESSEE AGREES THAT ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS OF A PARTICULAR PURPOSE ARE HEREBY DISCLAIMED BY SIGNING THIS CONTRACT, LESSEE AGREES THAT NO EXPRESS WARRANTY AS TO THE CONDITION OR PERFORMANCE OF ANY EQUIPMENT AND/OR PROPERTY LEASED BY LESSEE IS HEREBY DISCLAIMED.
14. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT:** the Rental Agreement constitutes the full agreement between Lessor and lessee. Time is of the essence in the Rental Agreement. The receipt of the AIR JUMP UNIT that is the subject of this Rental Agreement is in good working order.
15. **WEATHER POLICY:** The Lessor reserves the right not to perform outdoor engagements when, in the Lessor's judgment, weather conditions would be detrimental to the Lessor's equipment. This includes but is not limited to wind, rain, or mud. DURING PERIOD OF POTENTIALLY DETRIMENTAL WEATHER CONDITIONS (I.E. RAIN, HIGH WIND, ETC.) WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CANCEL YOUR RESERVATIONS, IF CONDITIONS ARE NOT TOO SEVERE, WE MAY GIVE YOU THE OPTION OF KEEPING YOUR RESERVATION OR CANCELLING. Once the equipment arrives at the event, the payment is required and is not refundable.
